Putrajaya, a planned city located just south of Kuala Lumpur, is the new federal administrative capital of Malaysia.

Several Government offices have relocated there to gain relief from the overcrowding and congestion of Kuala Lumpur, which is Malaysia's largest city.

However, Kuala Lumpur still serves as Malaysia's national and legislative capital for now.

## **DAY 5 - FRIDAY 26 FEB - KUALA LUMPUR-CAMERON HIGHLANDS (B/L/D)**

Morning depart for Cameron Highlands which is situated at 1520m above sea level. This is Malaysia's green bowl supplying vegetables to the major cities of the country and to Singapore.

The cool climate makes it an excellent tea growing area and indeed the Cameron tea is highly prized in the world market. With temperatures ranging between 25 and 10 degrees Celsius, this place is popular all year round with tourists.

## DAY 7 - SUNDAY 28 FEB - MALACCA-JOHOR BHARU (B/L)

Morning after breakfast check-out of hotel and proceed for a short sightseeing tour of Malacca. This historic city of Malacca is a living museum, with both ruins and intact buildings from bygone era is right in the heart of the town.



The Stadthuys - known as the Red Square, is a historical structure situated in the heart of Malacca Town. It was built by the Dutch occupants in 1650 as the office of the Dutch Governor and Deputy Governor. Thereafter proceed further south toward the state of Johor and visit Batu Pahat, Paloh and Nyor.

After lunch drive toward Johor Bahru. Johor Bahru is the southernmost gate of Malaysia bordered Singapore. It is linked with Singapore via the one kilometer causeway to Woodland.

Drive past Istana Bukit Serene (the resident of the Sultan) atop Bukit (hill) Serene, which was General Yamashita's headquarters where he coordinated the downfall of Singapore.

Overnight at **Puteri Pacific Johor Bharu** for 3 nights  
(5 Star - Princess Deluxe Room)

## DAY 8 - MONDAY - 1 MARCH - JOHOR BHARU (B/L)

Morning drive to Kluang and enroute visit a pineapple plantation. Johor is one of the main producers of pineapple in Malaysia. After lunch visit the Royal 5<sup>th</sup> Malaya Camp. After visit return to Johor Bharu. After visit return to hotel and free at leisure.

Overnight stay at **Puteri Pacific Johor Bharu**.

## DAY 9 - TUESDAY - 2 MARCH - JOHOR BHARU (B/L/D)

Morning drive to Kota Tinggi for a visit to Plada the Jungle Training School. After lunch return to Johor Bharu and proceed for sightseeing of the city

## **DAY 10 - WEDNESDAY 3 MARCH 2010 - JOHOR BHARU- SINGAPORE (B/L)**

After tour proceed for lunch at Changi Village Hotel.

After lunch visit Chinatown. Singapore's Chinatown evolved around 1821 when the first Chinese junk arrived from Xiamen, Fujian province in China. The passengers, all men, set up home around the south of the Singapore River which is known today as Telok Ayer.

Drive past other ethnic quarters like Arab Street and Little India.

Our next stop will be the "Colonial" heart of Singapore where you will take a short stroll to view the Merlion from next to the Esplanade theatre. After tour check-in to hotel.

Overnight stay at **Swissotel Merchant Court** for 5 nights (*4 Star hotel - Standard Room*)
